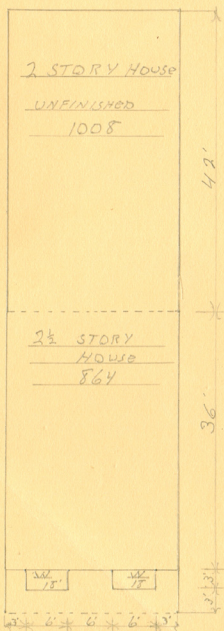

Building on new section. Upstairs garage or storage room. Downstairs addition to store used as a work room cleaning and pressing. Cement foundation. Frame construction. 88 Main St. Edward Kroot; bounded as follows:-Commence at the southeasterly corner of the homestead premises of Dr. Richard C. March on the northerly side of Main St.; thence easterly by said Main St. to the southerly end of the bank wall between this lot and the lawn of the homestead premises of Guy Monk, formerly owned by Beale M. Bennett; thence northerly by said wall to a point opposite a large elm tree near the end of said wall, said part to be marked by an iron stake set in the ground; thence westerly on a line parallel with said Main St. to the easterly line of homestead premises of said Richard C. March and thence southerly by said March premises to the point of commencement.
